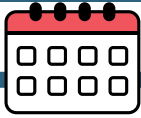

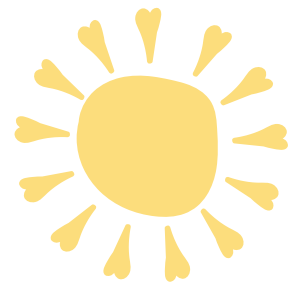

RMOL PARENT PORTAL

To log into the portal you will need; your child's PEN number and date of birth. PEN numbers can be found on your child's previous report card.

Please complete by February 24th, 2025

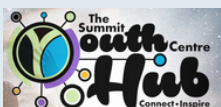
To complete the survey:

RMOL Test Invigilation Protocols for students:

1. All tests are written on site at: at GAS, KAS, or Open Doors
2. Students need to connect with their course teacher to schedule a test time
3. Students will:
 - a. Arrive with their RMOL username and password
 - b. Log in using a school laptop
 - c. Log in via D2L Brightspace course page
 - d. All personal devices during a test (Cell phone away. No earbuds use)
 - e. Only the RMOL test site tab can be open during the test. Formula sheets will be provided for students
 - f. Connect with the site teacher prior to submitting their test
